



Sharing Baptismal Treasures and Stories

1. Send a note home to parents/guardians explaining that the children will have an opportunity to share stories about their baptisms.
2. Ask the parents to find a picture or memento such as a gown or a candle that their children can bring to religion class.
3. Ask the parents to talk with their children about the child's baptism day.
4. Have the parents share who attended the baptism, where it was, and why the day was so special.
5. In class, give each child an opportunity to share with the rest of the group the memento and the stories their parents shared with them.
