

Making a Class Covenant

1. Explain to the group that as you begin a new catechetical year, this is an appropriate time to set a class covenant.
2. Explain that you will be writing this covenant together and that everyone will be invited to sign their name as a sign of their promise to follow the covenant.
3. Ask the group to share their ideas for what they would like to have included in the covenant. Possibilities might include: listen while others are speaking, treat each other with respect, share our ideas, live our faith, or participate.
4. Record their ideas on the “Class Covenant.”
5. Next, invite each member of the group to sign the covenant.
6. Post the covenant where it will remind the group of the promises they have made to one another.
