

# Letter to the World

In this chapter, the young people learn about how the pope, as the successor of Peter, stands up for the teachings of Christ. One way the popes over the centuries have done this is by writing letters to the faithful.

Using newsprint and a marker, ask the youth to brainstorm things they would say if the Pope asked them for advice on how to help the People of God follow Jesus today. List their responses on the newsprint.

Then, distribute paper and pens. Invite each participant to write a Letter to the World, giving advice and ideas for how people everywhere can live the Gospel message that Jesus taught.

Be sure to have the young people read their letters to each other. Post them where others can read them as well.
