Dramatizing Paul's Conversion

- 1. Distribute Bibles and read together Acts 9: 1-30.
- 2. List all the parts for the play and assign them.
- 3. Talk about sound effects that the children may be able to include in the play and assign people to provide the sounds. *If possible, make simple costumes from towels, sheets or robes. Provide time to prepare the play.*
- 4. Present the play to parents or other groups of children.
