Acting Out Scripture Stories

Put together a costume box. An assortment of sheets, cords, and kitchen towels is all you need. Use the sheets and cords to make robe-like clothing. Use towels and cords for head coverings.

Make character name tags to hang around the actors' necks. This will help the children in the audience remember the characters.

Act out the stories many times. If possible, give all the children an opportunity to act out the story. The repetition will help the children remember the story. Also, children who are shy may be more willing to volunteer after watching others.
