



Putting Actions to the Proverbs

1. Invite the children to each choose a proverb they like from the chapter.
2. Then have the children circle the action words and important words in their proverb. For example, if they chose the proverb at the top of page 217, they would choose the following words: speak, kindly, you, peace, harshly, enemies.
3. Explain that the children can make-up an action for each of these words.
4. Provide an opportunity for the children to share their proverb and actions with the rest of the group.
