



Asking “What If?”

1. Explain to the children that you are going to ask them some questions. After each question, you want them to share with you what they imagine life might be like. For example:
 - What if children didn’t have to go to school? What do you think would happen?
 - What if children could eat anything they wanted? What do you think would happen?
 - What if children could go to bed at any time they chose? What do you think would happen?
 - What if children could get drivers’ licenses before age sixteen? What do you think would happen?
2. Conclude with a discussion of why rules are important.
 - Why do parents and schools give us rules?
 - Why does God give us the Ten Commandments?
