



Honoring Those Who Taught Us to Pray

1. Ask the children to think of a person who has taught them how to pray.
2. Then invite the children to write this person's name on the chalkboard.
3. When all the names are on the board, lead the children in praying a litany.
The litany could be something like this:

Leader: Loving God, we gather today to thank you for the wonderful people in our lives who have taught us how to pray. We take time now to mention them by name, and honor them.

Leader: For _____, _____ and _____.

All: Thank you for teaching us to pray.

(Continue this prayer until all the names have been mentioned. Then close with the following prayer.)

Leader: Lord of all, thank you for the gift that each of these people is to us.
Help us remember to live what each one has taught us. Amen.
