

Holding a Press Conference

- 1. Invite about four volunteers to play the roles of Jesus, two bystanders, and a moderator. These volunteers will be the ones interviewed at the press conference.
- 2. The rest of the group will be the reporters. Distribute 3x5 note cards to them, and explain that you are giving them their credentials. Without their credentials they will not be allowed into the press conference.
- 3. Review what the children have learned in this chapter about the death, resurrection, and ascension of Jesus.
- 4. Next, give the reporters a few minutes to write down three questions that they would like to ask during the press conference.
- 5. While the reporters write their questions, answer any questions that Jesus, the two bystanders, and the moderator may have.
- 6. Explain that the moderator will call on reporters and direct the questions to Jesus or to the bystanders.
- 7. When everyone is ready, begin the press conference.
