

Playing a Ten Commandments Game

- 1. Divide the children into two teams.
- 2. On a large piece of poster board, write the Roman numerals I-X.
- 3. Give each team a beanbag. Explain that the teams and team members will take turn tossing the beanbags onto the board.
- 4. If the team member who tosses the beanbag can recite the commandment that corresponds to the nearest number, the team wins a point.
- 5. Play the game until a team has ten points or until most of the children are familiar with all Ten Commandments.
