



Playing a Ten Commandments Game

1. Divide the children into two teams.
2. On a large piece of poster board, write the Roman numerals I-X.
3. Give each team a beanbag. Explain that the teams and team members will take turn tossing the beanbags onto the board.
4. If the team member who tosses the beanbag can recite the commandment that corresponds to the nearest number, the team wins a point.
5. Play the game until a team has ten points or until most of the children are familiar with all Ten Commandments.
