



Great Stories

Materials needed: Children's Illustrated Bible, drawing paper, crayons, pencils, and markers

Prior to this activity, you may wish to read the accounts from the above mentioned Bible stories.

1. Have children choose their favorite story or assign small groups a specific story. If you choose the latter, give each child a certain part of the assigned story to illustrate.

For example: Noah and His Ark

Noah listening to God's voice;

Noah telling his family about the job he was told to do;

Noah building the ark;

Noah gathering the animals;

The ark in the flood;

Noah sending the dove;

God sends a rainbow.

2. Gather all the story segments and staple into a book for the children to enjoy.
